New Delhi: State Bank of India has refused to disclose the standard operating procedure (SOP) issued to its authorised branches for sale and redemption of electoral bonds.

In its response on March 30 to an RTI application, SBI refused to share the information, citing the "exemption" clause of Right to Information Act. SBI said the SOP was meant only for "internal circulation"

Transparency activist Anjali Bhardwaj, in her RTI application dated March 4, sought a copy of the SOP related to electoral bonds since April 2017. Not satisfied with the response, Bhardwaj will be filing an appeal.






